

## New Wound Care Clinic ACCELERATING YOUR QUALITY OF LIFE

For patients living with a deep or chronic wound, everyday activities can be a battle. Without proper treatment patients may suffer for years without any improvement, or even worse, may face amputation.

JRMC has partnered with Accelecare®, a leader in advanced wound care, in a shared arrangement to establish onsite, outpatient programs that focus on chronic and non-healing wounds. Using cutting edge treatments and sophisticated case management, JRMC and Accelecare® will help patients improve the quality of their lives.

Types of treatment at the new JRMC Wound Care Clinic will include hyperbaric medicine, debridement, whirlpool therapy and vacuum assisted closures.

#### HYPERBARIC CHAMBER ADVANCEMENT

Your body's tissues need an adequate supply of oxygen to function. When tissue is injured, it requires even more oxygen to survive. Hyperbaric oxygen therapy increases the amount of oxygen your blood can carry. An increase in blood oxygen temporarily restores normal levels of blood gases and tissue function to promote healing and fight infection.

Best known for treating undersea divers, hyperbaric chambers are more commonly used to treat patients facing the potential loss of limbs because of slow-healing, infected wounds. Diabetes and poor circulation frequently lead to deep foot wounds that resist other treatment.

Patients typically lie in a phone booth-sized chamber, breathing pressurized 100 percent oxygen for two hours a day, every weekday, for six weeks. The oxygen stimulates the body to grow new blood vessels in an injured area, boosting circulation and promoting healing.

The hyperbaric chambers also are used to help repair tissue damaged by cancer radiation treatments as well as to treat smoke inhalation, complicated bone or tissue infections, carbon monoxide exposure and scuba diving injuries.

If you have a wound that has not started to heal in two weeks, or is not completely healed in six weeks, you may be a candidate for wound care treatment.

Frances Rude developed a pressure point in her foot that quickly turned for the worse. She was brought in to JRMC for surgery. Dr. Steven Maier operated to clean the deep wound. Soon after Rude began seeing Julie Schulz, Physical Therapist and Stephanie Schmidt, Aide in the JRMC Rehabilitation department for whirlpool therapy.

It was a difficult and slow process. However, Rude's daughters Donna Fischer and Kathy Vandeberghe accompanied her to every appointment. They enjoyed the time together and with their mom. "If we had a bad week, they (Schulz and Schmidt) were there for us. If it wouldn't have been for the care by Dr. Maier and JRMC Rehab, her foot would have been amputated," said Donna Fischer.

As a testimonial of excellent care, Rude's family designated gifts and memorials to JRMC Foundation.

"Thank you JRMC Rehab department, you treated her so well and with respect,"

says Vandeberghe.

#### **MARY SMITH**

Mary Smith is also a deep wound care patient at JRMC. She suffers from lymphedema and cellulitis, a common, potentially serious skin infection. If untreated, the spreading infection may rapidly turn life-threatening. That's why Smith turned to JRMC to receive whirlpool therapy. "I called it going to the spa," says Smith who noted that humor helped her stay focused on recovery. Treatment is a slow process and Smith did get frustrated at times when she didn't see progress.

"I couldn't speak highly enough about the staff at JRMC. They were very kind and patient. They gave me confidence that treatment would work," says Smith.


#### Examples of wounds we treat:

- · diabetic wounds
- pressure ulcers
- venous stasis ulcers
- arterial wounds
- vasculitic wounds
- non-healing surgical wounds
- · traumatic wounds
- · infected wounds

#### Uses for hyperbaric oxygen therapy:

- bubbles of air in your blood vessels (arterial gas embolism)
- diabetic foot ulcers
- decompression sickness
- · carbon monoxide poisoning
- a wound that won't heal
- a crushing injury
- gangrene
- skin or bone infection that causes tissue death
- radiation injuries
- burns
- skin grafts or skin flaps at risk of tissue death
- severe anemia



One afternoon in mid-November, JRMC Hospice nurse Jeanette Weiss came into my office and said, "We should get David Donegan to a Bison game." David is a JRMC Hospice patient with Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), often referred to as Lou Gehrig's disease. He is also a huge North Dakota State University (NDSU) Bison fan.

In a Bison game day, you can see him decked out in green and gold Bison gear and cheering for his favorite team. Jeanette, knowing that David's health was deteriorating, wanted him to experience a game in person while it was still possible. However, the last home game of the season was scheduled just a couple weeks away. It was also sold out.

Tickets would be released to the public on a first come, first serve basis on November 30th starting at 8:00 am. With the hope we'd get tickets, calls were placed to arrange David's travel and special care needs.

I spoke with Ava Maria Village, where David lives, to see if we could use their bus and driver. I called Frank Redlin, JRMC Hospice volunteer for David, to see if he could accompany him on the trip for care. Then I checked with David's significant other Jean Hagel, to see if they would in fact like to go. Finally, we touched based with Patricia Dardis to see if the John Dardis Memorial Hospice Gift Fund at JRMC Foundation would sponsor the tickets. Everyone agreed.

Next, to get the tickets. After many redials, I was able to get through to the NDSU ticket office and obtain three tickets for the game! JRMC Hospice staff talked to David and he was absolutely thrilled to go.

Our plan was set in motion. On December 7, David and Jean and Frank Redlin attended the semifinal game to see the two-time national champion Bison beat Furman University. David had a blast and was smiling for days afterwards... and still grins from ear to ear when you ask him about the game.


to be enjoying Sunday breakfast at Perkins.
