Although it was the end of an era at the facility, it was the beginning of tremendous growth and opportunity for both JRMC and its patients.

Jennifer recalls, "It was kind of weird walking in (to the old hospital). All the boxes were there and we felt like we were the only patients." She and Aaron prepared themselves for the possibility of Miles' birth at either the old or new medical facility. After his birth, they were transferred by ambulance to the new Jamestown Regional Medical Center.

"Although the building was new, the nurses and care were the same," says Jennifer. "We had the birth experience that we wanted."

Today, Miles is thriving at five. He is all smiles and hugs. He likes to play with ponies and Legos and swim. He is also the proud big brother of Alice, born at JRMC three years ago.

She drives over an hour each way on Thursdays to donate her time. She makes drive because she “absolutely loves her volunteer job at JRMC.”

Larry Tag, a JRMC Rehabilitation and Telecare volunteer, shares, jokes and interacts with patients to keep their spirits up. One patient was particularly distraught about having broken her hip. She felt as though her once active life was coming to a halt. But, Larry was the crucial piece of the puzzle that turned her attitude around. By the time of her discharge, her spirits were lifted.

Kathy Wegner often works a full day in the JRMC Gift Shoppe, filling the next shift if there is a void. She also helps to recruit new volunteers, even training the newest gift shoppe workers.

Our volunteers make a tremendous impact on patient care. The average hours volunteered over a lifetime is 738.5. The average hours per year is 80! However, per person hours vary drastically from a few a month to over 16. 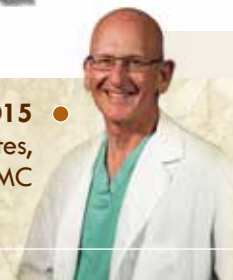

His gift also created a fund for ongoing campus grounds and facility expansion and revitalization.

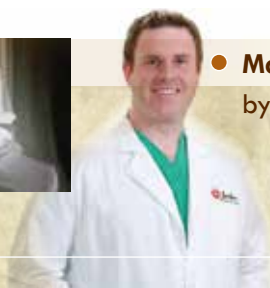

MEET THE FUTURE OF CARE

We are building it.

“The board’s focus will continue to be the expansion of services to meet the medical needs of the community,” —says Dennis D. Pozarnsky, JRMC Board of Directors Chair

The ability to retain doctors and nurses and the availability of specialties are the TOP two public health concerns from the 2015 Community Health Needs Assessment. In order to address these concerns, physician recruitment and placement is a top priority for JRMC in the following areas: emergency, orthopedics, obstetrics and gynecology, oncology, otolaryngology (ENT) and cardiology. Renovations started in JRMC Clinic to accommodate the newest specialists listed below. Pictured above is the future space for cancer care.

EMERGENCY

JRMC has hired a new emergency department physician, Dr. Ben Muscha, originally from Harvey, ND. He is a board-certified family medicine physician who is experienced providing care in both emergency and family medicine settings. K.C. DeBoer, president and CEO of JRMC says “Having more emergency medicine physicians on staff allows for more consistent care in our emergency department for our patients.” Dr. Muscha graduated from the UND School of Medicine and completed his residency at the UND Family Practice Center, Grand Forks, ND.

ORTHOPEDICS

The JRMC Clinic is expanding orthopedic services and will begin taking appointments in August with Dr. Timothy Volk, Orthopedic Surgeon. Volk graduated from Bismarck High School and still has family in the area. He received his undergraduate degree from Moorhead State University, Moorhead, MN and his Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine at Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine and residency at Millcreek Community Hospital, both in Erie, PA. He will help balance Dr. Micheal Dean’s current services, offering sports medicine and upper extremity procedures along with other traditional orthopedic care.

OBSTETRICS & GYNECOLOGY

JRMC Family BirthPlace is the only birth center for 90 miles. While family practice physicians are providing most of the delivery services, there was a void for high-risk obstetrics and diverse gynecology services. Starting the summer of 2017, Dr. Bailey Runkles, OB-GYN will offer women and families her expertise in those areas. She is currently a third year OB-GYN resident at the Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences, Tulsa, OK.

WOUND CARE

Amanda Lausch, FNP joined the JRMC Clinic wound care team and has over 16 years of experience in wound care. She recently spent a week in Billings, MT, shadowing their wound care physicians and a week in Jacksonville, FL, training in wound care and hyperbaric oxygen bringing best practices to our center.

ONCOLOGY

The number one priority for progress is getting the oncology project accomplished at JRMC. The key step in progress is recruiting a provider. Details continue to be finalized, but JRMC believes we have found that person.

Having a dedicated oncologist will trigger the start of chemotherapy services and the next phase of our Journey to Oncology campaign: space for a cancer center.

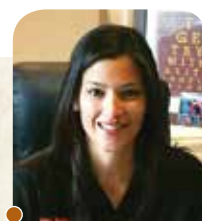
